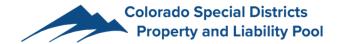

 roof surface for moisture protection, as well as roof flashing, vent covers and gutters.
- Cosmetic damage means that the wind and/or hail caused marring, pitting or other superficial damage that
 altered the appearance of the roof surfacing, but such damage does not prevent the roof from continuing to
 function as a barrier to entrance of the elements to the same extent as it did before the cosmetic damage
